Title: A Neighbouring Planetary System Reveals its Secrets		
Using ESO's VLT to peer at a nearby system of exoplanets, astronomers have made startling new discoveries.		
2. The planets orbit a star just 35 light-years away. Some of them resemble those in our inner Solar System.		
3. The planet closest to the star was found to have half the mass of Venus – making it the lightest planet measured with the radial velocity technique.		
4. The third planet could be a "water world", with water making up to 30% of its mass.		
5. The team also found hints of another terrestrial planet, one in the habitable zone. It could even have liquid water at its surface – just like Earth.		
6. This system may have even more fascinating secrets to reveal. Stay tuned!
