The site offers numerous off-road options, but

today Margaret chooses Paranal's "Star Track" for

her excursion. This path leads from the Residencia up to the Paranal summit. Although the dryness and the altitude effects are always noticeable, Margaret typically bikes for about an hour before she returns.
